 2. A direct donation through this portal is not a percentage of the proceeds against the sales done on behalf of a honoree
 3. The ticket description will reference the Honoree, Charity of Choice, Website of the Charitable Organization
 4. Honoree should get permission from a Charity to allow YGB Entrepreneurial Awards to use their Logo, Name & Information
 5. Upon checkout the individuals must complete an order form to confirm their donation
 6. YGB Entrepreneurial Awards will forward to each charity a list of all donors, donation amount & contact information within two weeks after the conclusion of the 2018 YGB Entrepreneurial Awards
 7. Donations are **NON-REFUNDABLE**
 8. All charities must be a registered 501 (c) 3 entity
